ISSUE:
Approve an ordinance to appoint Robert Lock as Ward 3 Alderman through the second meeting in April 2015.

BACKGROUND:
Missouri statute RSMo 79.280 and Parkville Municipal Code Section 110.120 states that for vacancies in any elected office, the mayor shall call a meeting of the Board of Aldermen to nominate a successor with the advice and consent of a majority of the remaining members of the Board and serve until the next general election. Alderman Kendall Welch resigned effective December 16, 2014, leaving a vacancy for a Ward 3 alderman for the remainder of the term.

Mayor Johnston appointed a subcommittee of Aldermen to interview candidates for the position. She is nominating Robert Lock to fill the vacancy for Ward 3 alderman to serve until the second meeting in April 2015 following the next general municipal election, when the term expires.

BUDGET IMPACT:
There is no impact to the budget.

ALTERNATIVES:

1. Accept the Mayor's nomination by voice vote.
2. Reject the Mayor's nomination and request alternative nominations.
3. Postpone action.

POLICY:
Parkville Municipal Code Section 110.120, the Mayor, with consent and approval of the Board of Aldermen, is to nominate a successor to fill elected office vacancies.

SUGGESTED MOTION:
I move that Bill No. 2826, an ordinance appointing Robert Lock to serve as Ward 3 Alderman until the second meeting in April 2015, be approved on first reading.

I move that Bill No. 2826 be approved on first reading and passed to second reading by title only.

AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING ROBERT LOCK TO SERVE AS WARD 3 ALDERMAN UNTIL THE SECOND MEETING IN APRIL 2015.


WHEREAS, the Mayor has nominated Ward 3 resident Robert Lock to fill said alderman seat until the second meeting in April 2015 following the general municipal election.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF PARKVILLE, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Robert Lock is hereby designated to serve as Alderman in Ward 3 to fill the vacancy created by former Alderman Kendall Welch. The term of office shall be from this date until the second meeting in April 2015.

Section 2. This ordinance is effective upon its passage and approval.


