Any damage(s) found after the start of construction will be required to be repaired by the permittee.

I, the undersigned, have read the referenced conditions herein and hereby certify and affirm by my signature that I understand said conditions and agree to abide by the same. I further understand that any violations from the provisions of said codes or conditions of approval identified herein shall constitute cause for the retraction of this permit and enforcement and penalties as prescribed by the Parkville Municipal Code shall be applied, including penalties not exceeding a fine of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) and costs, or imprisonment for a term not exceeding ninety (90) days, or both such fine and imprisonment. I understand that each day in which any violation exists shall constitute a separate offense. I further understand, this agreement shall be binding upon the owner or his or her successors in title.
