
Executive Summary Report with Charts

Population Demographics

The number of households in the study area in 1990 was **1,239** and changed to **1,656** in 2000, representing a change of **33.6%**. The household count in Spring 2010 was **1,916** and the household projection for 2015 is **2,169**, a change of **13.2%**.


The population in the study area in 1990 was **3,562** and in 2000 it was **4,506**, roughly a **26.5%** change. The population in Spring 2010 was **5,301** and the projection for 2015 is **5,917** representing a change of **11.6%**.

Population by Age




In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **29.7**, and in 2000, it was **35.2**. The median age in Spring 2010 is **37.5** and it is predicted to change in five years to **38.9** years. In Spring 2010, females represented **50.8%** of the population with a median age of **38.1** and males represented **49.2%** of the population with a median age of **37.0** years. In Spring 2010, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 45 to 54** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **75 +** years.

 F: Other or Multi Race


