Sandbagging efforts will begin at 2:00 pm today in the municipal parking in downtown Parkville and will continue through 10:00 pm. Volunteers must check in at the American Legion (11 Main Street) to register and obtain ID.

Volunteers must be 16 or older and are asked to bring photo IDs, gloves, work boots, hat, sunscreen and bug spray for their personal uses. The City will provide drinking water, but volunteers are advised to bring food and drinks for their personal use just in case. The city expects to utilize automated sand bag filing equipment, but volunteers with ready access to shovels are advised to bring them.

Volunteers may park at the Parkville Community Center/YMCA (8875 Clark Avenue, east lot adjacent to 9 Highway), at Park University (8700 NW River Park Drive, parking at Main entrance) and on the ball fields in downtown Parkville (take East Street entrance to cross the railroad tracks – Main Street will be closed at the railroad tracks). Busses will be shuttle volunteers from the community center / YMCA and Park University locations to downtown and back.
