MILL AND OVERLAY EXISTING ASPHALT PAVEMENT

THE UNDERSIGNED BIDDER, having examined the Instructions to Bidders, Contract Forms, Specifications, General Conditions, Special Conditions, and other related Contract Documents referred to herein, and any and all Addenda thereto; the location, arrangement, and construction of existing railways, highways, streets, roads, structures, utilities, and facilities which affect or may be affected by the Work; the topography and condition of the site of the Work; and being acquainted with and fully understanding (a) the extent and character of the Work covered by this Bid Form; (b) the location, arrangement, and specified requirements of and for the proposed structures and miscellaneous items of Work appurtenant thereto; (c) the nature and extent of the excavations to be made, and the type, character and general condition of the materials to be excavated; (d) the necessary handling and re-handling of excavated materials; (e) all existing and local conditions relative to construction difficulties and hazards, labor, transportation, hauling, trucking and rail delivery facilities; and (f) all local conditions, laws, regulations, and all other factors and conditions affecting or which may be affected by the performance of the Work required by the Contract Documents.
