The Parkville Trading Company was formed in 2012 and is working with Park University students who are interested in starting their own business. Chair: Mary Hayslett

Partnerships Committee focuses on developing partnerships/relationships with our local, regional and state partners such as the Chamber, Main Street, Park Hill School District, Platte County EDC, KCADC, MARC, the Missouri Department of Economic Development and many others. This committee serves as the government relations arm of the board. It will review federal and state legislation that has potential impact on businesses and economic development in Parkville. Highway 9 Task Force will assist City with relationships that will encourage development and partnerships for future improvements to Highway 9 corridor. Parkville received a planning grant for corridor study to improve traffic circulation, safety, and aesthetics on State Route 9.
