

Platte Landing Park Off-Leash Dog Park Guide



Platte Landing Park is home to Platte County's first public off-leash dog parks, including a large and small dog park named for their size. The large dog park is 3 acres and the small dog park is 2 acres, both fenced with a double gated entry for safety. The dog parks offer amenities for the dogs to enjoy. No other use is permitted unless by special event permit.

Hours of Operation: 5 a.m. to midnight

Rules for People

- ◆ No cell phones.
- ◆ Use dog parks at your own risk. The City is not liable for any injury or damage caused by any dog in the dog parks. You are responsible for any injuries caused by the dog(s) you brought to the dog parks.
- ◆ Children may inadvertently engage in behavior that can trigger a dog's prey drive or natural instinct to chase. To ensure safety, children under the age of 8 are discouraged in the dog parks. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Adults bring children into the dog parks at their own risk.
- ◆ All park gates must remain closed at all times other than during entry and/or exit; only one gate shall be open at any one time and then only to enter or exit.
- ◆ Each handler is limited to a maximum of 2 dogs at one time and must have one leash in hand for each dog and have the dog under his/her control.
- ◆ Handlers must clean up after their dogs, removing and disposing of pet waste in a sealed plastic bag and placing the bag in a trash can. Owners shall repair any holes dug by dogs that they brought to the dog parks.
- ◆ Smoking, alcoholic beverages, human food and glass containers are prohibited. Training treats for dogs are permitted.
- ◆ Any bite of a person or other dog must be immediately reported to Police. The persons and dogs involved must wait for an officer to respond, except when immediate medical care is needed.



Rules for Dogs

- ◆ Must have current rabies vaccination and wear a visible tag on a collar at all times.
 - ◆ Must be leashed until inside the dog parks.
- ◆ Must be under control of and within view of their owners/handlers at all times.
 - ◆ Aggressive dogs are prohibited.
- ◆ Dogs under 4 months and female dogs in heat are prohibited.
- ◆ Choke, prong and spiked collars are prohibited on all dogs in the dog parks.
 - ◆ Must be leashed and removed at first sign of aggression toward people or other dogs. Mounting behavior is not allowed.
- ◆ Dogs with communicable diseases or open sores or wounds are prohibited.
