Local Use Tax in Parkville



TRAILS PRIORITIES FOR PARKVILLE



Dear Parkville residents,

The Board of Aldermen placed two tax initiatives on the November 7th ballot. Prop T, a Use Tax (online sales tax), will be dedicated to trails and transportation.

The proposition was placed on the ballot because the City has no dedicated source of funds to maintain and expand our trail system, match federal funds for major projects, or to maintain our infrastructure. If we want our trails, streets, curbs and sidewalks maintained, we need dedicated funds.

This is an important issue for your city, so please take a few minutes to vote on November 7th at the Presbyterian Church on Main Street.

BALLOT LANGUAGE

For the purpose of funding roads, infrastructure and capital projects, including, without limitation, capital grant related projects requiring City of Parkville matching funds, including 9 Highway at East Street (triangle), future phases of 9 Highway (between 6th Street and Lakeview Drive) and the Bell Road connectivity project for sidewalks; and funding for the construction, maintenance, and repair of, and improvements to, pedestrian corridors, multi-use trails, and recreation trails, shall the City of Parkville, Missouri, impose a local use tax at the same rate as the total local City sales tax rate, currently two and one-half percent (2.50%), provided that if the local sales tax rate is reduced or raised by voter approval, the local use tax rate shall also be reduced or raised by the same action?

A YES vote means the voter approves the collection of a use tax for online purchases.

A NO vote means no use tax will be collected.
